

ALLGORITHIM Presents: "Asking God for Gas" - A Solo Online Exhibition by Cole Cavlin

October 27 – November 27, 2024

Los Angeles, CA – Gallery ALLGORITHIM is excited to announce Asking God for Gas, a solo online exhibition by Los Angeles-based artist Cole Cavlin. This virtual showcase will be available from October 27 to November 27, 2024, inviting audiences from around the world to engage with Cavlin's exploration of grit, survival, and beauty amidst the chaotic landscapes of contemporary urban life.

In Asking God for Gas, Cole Cavlin reflects on themes of scarcity, resilience, and the paradoxes of city life. His works combine oil paint, concrete, street-found objects, textile remnants, journal entries, and scrap metal to evoke the complex textures of downtown Los Angeles, where he has spent the past four years living and working in various art studios. His pieces speak to both the rawness and the romance of a transient existence, underscoring his sacrifices for art while capturing his unique vision of the urban landscape.

During the pandemic, Cavlin expanded his creative range by launching the fashion label **cd1974**, producing one-of-a-kind garments for prominent musicians and artists, including Lenny Kravitz, Camila Cabello, Slash, and Dave Chappelle. His collections, featured on runways and available at Domicile Tokyo, Church Boutique in Los Angeles, and Retail Pharmacy in NYC, reflect his dedication to originality and craft. In April 2024, he premiered *Dying in Nature*, a Western short film he co-wrote and directed, marking his foray into film and further establishing him as a multifaceted artist.

Asking God for Gas captures Cole's journey of obsession, creativity, and survival. Through his unique use of found materials, he brings beauty to the overlooked and mundane, imbuing each piece with the intensity of his lived experience.

The public is invited to view the exhibition online through the ALLGORITHIM website, beginning October 27, 2024. *Asking God for Gas* will be accessible worldwide through November 27, 2024.
